We set out on a journey to create a program that would provide comfort and support for children who were terminally ill, managing serious illness or experiencing trauma.

Comfort Bears was launched October 2021 providing soft and cuddly teddy bears with the intent of serving Hamilton, Halton and Niagara communities. It did not take long to realize the need was far reaching, and before long our service expanded from London, ON to Kenora, ON and everywhere in between.

The community responded with open arms understanding what we were trying to achieve. The comfort a teddy bear can provide cannot be underestimated. For many it's just a teddy bear, but for our kids receiving the bears, it provides someone to talk to and will never leave their side, no matter how difficult their situation might become.

Endless stories of tragedy, pain and medical crisis were shared with us. It can be difficult to fathom the strength and resilience of our kids and their families. When the child's eyes lock with their Comfort Bear and they give it that first tight hug, it reminds us of why Comfort Bears was started. **If we have provided, even for one second, a distraction and a feeling of love and hope, then we have achieved our goal.**

It was our intent to distribute 1,000 bears in our first two years of operation. Instead, we distributed 8,000 bears to 48 incredibly caring and supportive organization partners, who lovingly distributed Comfort Bears to children with whom they work.

None of this work would be possible without the enduring compassion, dedication and generosity of our donors and volunteers. Thank you for being by our side on this journey, every step of the way, as we bring comfort to some very special and brave kids.


Mission:
